The Peanut Island restoration will renovate historic Coast Guard buildings for ecotourism, which will add to the county's extensive 2005 renovation of the Island which created extensive recreational opportunities.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Planning and construction renovation of existing buildings and historic fallout bunker.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Florida residents will enjoy the opportunity to participate in recreational and ecotourism activities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents participating in recreational, historical, and ecotourism opportunities will utilize the benefits of the renovated island facilities.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

East Central Palm Beach County and the municipality of Riviera Beach will benefit by increased economic activity from the recreational, historic and ecotourism brought by the renovation. The island is only accessible by marine craft and water taxi, so the number of increased tourists can be measured.
