Phase 2 includes the design and construct a gravity sewer system for up to 132 homes. The gravity sewer system will include a sewerage lift station and force main. The project will also eliminate 132 septic tanks and associated groundwater discharges. The Town will invest \$1,000,000 to complete Phase 2. The Town has invested \$981,000 and completed Phase 1.
