12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of this request is to enlarge the existing fire station and purchase an emergency generator for emergency and disaster recovery situations. The additional space will enhance training capabilities, fire station functionality and foster community relations. A fire station this size would also be capable of hosting emergency personnel from other areas that may come in and assist the City or County during disaster recovery situations. This was discovered as a need for the community in the aftermath of Hurricane Michael.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project will also include the construction of two additional bays for fire fighting equipment, provide showers, commercial washer/dryer which is necessary to provide the firefighters with the adequate resource to wash any harmful cancer causing carcinogens from their bodies and clothing. This has been proven to reduce the risk of job related cancers among firefighters. It will also provide the space to host life-saving training on fire safety prevention and management to Liberty County's most vulnerable citizens; the elderly, school-aged children and firefighters.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Liberty County will be directly affected by this expansion in many ways:

- 1. Direct Firefighter training;
- 2. Community-wide fire safety training;
- 3. Life Saving decontamination procedures recommended by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA); and

4. Safe secure and protected area for all fire fighting apparatus and equipment.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire population of Liberty County Florida, near 9,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



1. The expected benefit or outcome would be improved training and awareness of our fire services to both the firefighters and the community.

2. Due to the high number of cancer related issues to firefighters and responding to emergency calls related to potential COVID-19 cases, the benefit would be to have a commercial washer/dryer to wash off carcinogens, viruses and other hazardous materials from their Bunker Gear.

3. A safe and secure facility for the firefighters and the community.
