Students will have educational space to receive instruction that is in a conducive setting.

Instruction will be provided to displaced students that will be delivered in a setting for individual grades and instructional privacy will be maintained. Schools will be more able to meet class size reduction specifics.

Students will have educational space to receive instruction that is in a more conducive setting.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

400 students in Pre-K through 12th grade in Calhoun County.

Instructional space will be provided to displaced students. By combining the BMS and BHS, there will be a reduction in operational costs by consolidating three school campuses into two sites. Evidence of these benefits will be realized in class size compliance and reduced operational costs.
