Funds will be used to match existing state dollars in an effort to expedite design and construction to implement centralized sewer in effort to abate existing septic tanks.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Services to be provided by this project include enhancing environmental quality, economic activity, improve wastewater management and improve surface water quality.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population to be served by this project is the citizens of Inglis, Florida. The town has a total population of 1,347.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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The Town of Inglis Sub-Regional Wastewater System project will enhance, preserve and improve environmental quality, increase and improve economic activity, wastewater management and surface water quality. The methods used to measure these outcomes are as follows:

United States Environmental Protection Agency studies; ongoing USDA preliminary engineering studies show the results of implementing a central sewer system would be direct management of the effluent discharge by the City or Regional provider, such that environmental compliance is ensured; USDA water/sewer economic impact study; environmental studies; FDEP permits; SWFWMD monitoring reports.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The project must meet the FDEP; SWFWMD and Fish and Wildlife permit requirements. If the project does not meet the standards of each department the effect will be addressed in permitting and license.
