Design, engineering and construction of Boat Dock, Boat House and new hull appropriate marine vessel. This project would improve Public Safety response times for marine incidents on the St. Johns River and provide more Public Safety presence on the river. Having the marine vessel housed securely on the river allows Public Safety staff to reduce response times. Presently, less than 2 boats are actually in the water at any time covering the St. Johns River from the Buckman to Shands Bridge.

Public Safety and Recreational activities
