12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To provide the city, citizens, and businesses with a central disaster response and recovery center. The completed community center would give the community a place where they can gather for social and cultural events.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will be used towards the completion of the ongoing construction of the new City Community Center.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

To provide the community with a location where pre- and post-disaster assistance activities can occur. This project would give the citizens of Gretna a place where they can gather as a community for social, cultural, educational or recreational activities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will service the entire City of Gretna. Based on census data there is a total population of 1,348 citizens. Of that population, approximately 29% fall below the poverty level. Additionally, 84% of the population is African-American, while another 12% is Hispanic.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome will be a completed, functional community center.
