Plans will be designed for a future consolidated government complex in Jackson County, on land already owned by the county. The site where the government facility will be located, will also house tourism and economic development efforts.

Jackson County will hire an engineering consulting firm to design plans for a future building that will provide accessibility and consolidation of all county services into one complex.

The facility will house county departments and constitutional offices. The complex will house the county Administration Department, Community Development Department (Building, Planning, and Housing), Tourism Development Council, Veteran's Services, Utilities, and elected County Commissioner's offices.

The future building will serve the 27,000 residents of Jackson County.

The project will provide for completed design plans of a consolidated government complex.
