12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funding would be used to conduct a comprehensive traffic analysis of the Lewis Turner Boulevard (State Road 189) area to determine if a new north-south roadway extension of Denton Boulevard is necessary. b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

There are numerous developments in various stages along the Lewis Turner Boulevard (State Road 189) corridor which will have a tremendous impact on traffic flow in south Okaloosa County. This traffic analysis will evaluate the options to alleviate traffic issues, provide better access to local schools, neighborhoods, and businesses, and add another north-south evacuation route out of south Okaloosa County.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improved traffic flow, improved access to local schools, and an additional hurricane evacuation route.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General public, K-8 school students & families, middle school students & families, and high school students & families. More than 1,000 persons will be served by this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



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be measured?

Protection of the general public from harm: Provides an additional hurricane evacuation route out of south Okaloosa County (measure # of citizens with access to hurricane evacuation route); Improve transportation conditions: Improves traffic flow in south Okaloosa County & access to local schools (traffic counts on Denton, Racetrack, & Lewis Turner); Increase or improve economic activity: Allows the city to redevelop a portion of the city's golf club property (increased revenue in sales tax dollars); and Increase tourism: Enhances the attractiveness of the area as a destination (# of visitors).

Revocation or repayment of funding.
