Improvements to the City of Crestview Community Center to harden this facility in order to be prepared in the event of a natural disaster such as a hurricane or tornado. This building can be used as a staging area for pre-storm rescue teams and fall out shelter in the event circumstances call for the need. The building would also be used as post-storm housing for search and rescue teams.

Improvement include: The replacement of two 16' wide x 10' tall roll up doors. The new doors will be hurricane wind load rated doors with high impact protection and insulated. The installation of a natural gas powered generator capable of providing power to pre-storm level. The addition of a full service kitchen with cooking and food preparation capabilities.
