12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of this project is to provide potable water to residents (through a centralized and permitted water system) who are currently served by private wells. Safe and reliable potable water will ensure that the risk for waterborne diseases is less likely to occur from a permitted water treatment plant. As such, the residents' public health will be enhanced. In addition, incidental roadway restoration, driveways, and fire suppression systems will be provided with this project.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The purpose of this project is to provide potable water to residents (through a centralized and permitted water system) who are currently served by private wells. Safe and reliable potable water will ensure that the risk from waterborne diseases; most likely to occur from unregulated private wells.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will provide water main distribution lines, service lines, fire hydrants, fittings, valves and related appurtenances, incidental road restoration/driveway restoration to the residents within these communities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will serve City of Miramar residents located within Country Club Estates, Country Club Ranches Section II, Miramar West, and Lago at Miramar communities.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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This project will ultimately provide potable water services to properties located in the public Right-of-Ways (ROWs) within the aforementioned subdivisions. The outcome will be measured by the health conditions, reduction in waterborne diseases, and overall sustainability of the residents.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The City would seek a reduction in financial obligation in the event critical deadlines are missed.
