The funding will allow the construction of resiliency improvements to a low-lying, flood-prone area within the City of St. Augustine Beach. The implementation of this project will reduce the severity and frequency of flooding due to storm surge and extreme tides associated with sea level rise. The project will significantly reduce the occurrence of flooding, thus providing significant long-term benefits by reducing property losses, increasing public safety and protecting public infrastructure.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction projects which reduce flooding.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents of St. Augustine Beach.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduced duration of standing water in residential areas to reduce spread of water-borne pathogens; the duration of standing water after a rainfall event will be recorded post-construction to measure and verify the level of benefit. Reduction of frequency of roadway inundation; Rainfall will be recorded and compared to any post construction roadway inundation to measure and verify the level of benefit. The project will provide jobs in the engineering and construction industries as required to design, permit and construct improvements; Estimates of staff hours will be required from the design and construction contractors.
