A SCADA System is an electronic and computer-based system which monitors and controls numerous components, processes, operation in and safety of the water and wastewater treatment plants. The current system consists of several independent components which have been compiled over the past 20 years with multi software platforms and components from various manufacturers. The proposed new SCADA system will allow us to bette identify operational issues, chemical imbalances, controls which may need adjustment, and under-performing equipment.
