Improved system functionality and reliability for the citizens of the City of St. Marks.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Through this request the City wishes to replace approximately 5,000 LF of aging watermain, replacement of 15 non-functional valves and the upgrade of 8 fire hydrants.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

An improved, more reliable potable water system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The improvements will serve the entirety of the St. Marks water system customers. There are approximately 244 residents within the City that would benefits from the improvements. The City currently has approximately 31.5% of it's residents that fall below the poverty line.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project will result in a system that is reliable and can be maintained efficiently and effectively. The total linear footage of new line, as well as the number of valves and hydrants replace will be recorded and reported.

If deliverables aren't met, the associated funding may be de-obligated from the City.
