a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Increased amount of waste water treated and additional reclaim water flow for irrigation needs. This will allow for the economy of the region to continue to expand.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Reconstruction of critical elements of the Waste Water Plant such as the Headworks, Biological Nutrient Removal basin, Clarifier Structure, Effluent Transfer Pump in addition to Yard piping new electrical connections and new mechanical buildings.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

An increase in the amount of wastewater that can be treated thus maintain appropriate service and reliability to the system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Citizens of the City of Clermont and unincorporated Lake County residents that are Utility customers of the City. In addition, the City of Clermont provides waste water treatment to all of the town of Oakland, Parts of the town of Montverde and parts of the City of Minneola.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefits will be an increase of treated wastewater available for reclaim water purposes. In addition the volume of flow can be measured from is current 4 MGD to the designed increase of 6.5MGD.
