#### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds requested will help construct a new well field. It will protect drinking water by diversifying the City's water supply. Hurricane Irma in 2017 resulted in the City of Alachua experiencing contamination of its water supply, preventing drinking water to all 10,000 residents and hundreds of businesses for more than a week. This occurred in large part due to the current wells supplying the drinking water are all geographically located close together and the karst geology of our region, which can be overwhelmed during storm events.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The City of Alachua will construct a new well field that will provide quality and reliable potable water to residents and businesses. The new well field will ensure diversity in water resources to protect against contamination of the City's entire potable water supply, thereby protecting the public.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The City of Alachua will provide quality and reliable potable water to residents and businesses. This project will diversify Alachua's water supply by ensuring there is another source of available potable water in the event of a natural disaster. Reliable potable water supply promotes a physically healthy population and a healthy business environment.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

City of Alachua residents. Population of 10,000. Businesses are 250+.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits are as follows: Improved drinking water quality; improved physical health; protecting the general public from harm; increasing or improving economic activity.
