	Completing the dredging, widening and berm removal of the next 1.5 miles of the remaining 6-1/4 miles of the channel & construction of the embankment for the linear park allows for improved water flow & filtration, cleaner water, provides for safer navigation, addresses permitting agencies regulations. Provides for direct access to the Lake & increased economic development venues to be hostedfishing, duck hunting, bird watching, hiking, wildlife enthusiasts & activities, etc., which increases tourism, State revenues & maintains employment. Glades County owns the largest area of Lake Okeechobee on the western shore & access to the Lake is vital to the economy in this fiscally constrained community & the Moore Haven Canal serves as the life line for the County. 3/4 mile was completed with SFWMD funding and multiple State agencies participating (SFWMD, FWC, TIIFT, FDEP). Glades County is located in a rural area of economic opportunity.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Goal is to dredge and widen 1.5 miles of the remaining 6-1/4 miles navigational channel & construct the embankment for the linear park which will improve water flow & filtration, resulting in cleaner water, and safer navigation. Glades County owns the largest area of Lake Okeechobee & access to the Lake is important to the economy. The Moore Haven Canal is the life line for the County that allows direct access to the Lake. Project provides for protection of State water resources, the public, tourists, visitors, citizenry & residents. Allows direct access to the Lake for revenue producing venues to be hosted for fishing, duck hunting, bird watching, hiking, wildlife enthusiasts & activities, etc. Addresses permitting agencies regulations, maintenance & reporting requirements.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds to be used for contractual engineering & construction services through the County's procurement policy to dredge and widen 1.5 miles of the remaining 6-1/4 mile channel & construct the embankment for the linear park. Tasks are engineering, design survey, soil analysis, permitting, photogrammetry, hydrologic modeling, bidding, earthwork, dewatering, turbidity control, water quality monitoring, mitigation planting, seeding, mulching & planting along the channel embankments, installing navigational aids, clearing & grubbing, wildlife surveys, maintenance of traffic for boaters, record surveys, final quantities, project management, etc.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens and tourists is for safer navigational waterways with direct access to the Lake, protection of State water resources, improved water flow & water quality.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is citizenry, residents, visitors, tourists, boating/fishing industry & the State.

The expected benefit/outcome to complete the widening and deepening of 1.5 miles of the 7-mile navigational channel that provides for safer navigation, improved water flow & filtration, local access to Lake Okeechobee for Glades residents, tourists, citizenry, etc. Provides for direct access to the Lake allowing for economic stabilization & development for activities such as local events to be hosted for fishing, boaters, duck hunters, bird watching, hiking, wildlife enthusiasts, etc.; increases tourism & State revenues; maintains employment. Addresses permitting agencies requirements, maintenance & reporting requirements
