To replace Riviera Beach Intracoastal Essential Lift Station 47. This includes a complete replacement of Master Pump Station #47 inclusive of pumping, mechanical, electrical, structural and ancillary systems as well as the pump station building. All equipment and structures are beyond useful life, spare parts are difficult to procure, station configuration limits operating flexibility and performance. This promotes elevated of sewage overflow risk and odor complaints. The facility is a major pump station that generally serves the area west of I-95, including the VA Hospital, and is therefore a critical priority for the City and the region.

To rehabilitate Riviera Beach Intracoastal Essential Lift Station 47. This includes a complete replacement of Master Pump Station #47 inclusive of pumping,/mechanical, electrical, structural and ancillary systems as well as the pump station building.

Construction and commissioning of the replacement lift station.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The upgraded wastewater pump station will enhance the reliability and reduce the risk of failure and overflows that have the potential to harm the environment. Impacts area west of C-17 canal. The upgraded wastewater pump station will also reduce incidences of odor complaints from neighboring residents, the potential for failure and associated sewage overflow and sanitary hazards and improve reliability of sewage disposal service provided to the VA hospital.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

A significant portion of the City's utility service population (approximately 12,000 people) in the area west of I-95 could potentially be impacted by a catastrophic failure of the pump station

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The likelihood of potential failures associated with sewage overflow that could harm the environment and can cause sanitary hazards would be reduced as well as reduced occurrence of odor complaints. The measure of outcome will be a reduction in the occurrence frequency and volume of overflows as well as odor complaints.
