12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To replace the existing aging water treatment plant (WTP) constructed in the 1950's that has been a challenge in consistently producing desired water quality, mainly due to inoperable equipment that is approaching the end of their functional life. The new membrane technology efficiently purifies the water beyond the capability of the existing technology and is expected to significantly reduced incidences of compliance actions. Resulting enhanced treatment barriers for microbial risks, disinfection byproducts and other regulated water quality parameters will enhance wellbeing and economic prospects of the City.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Pre-construction activities associated with the new WTP inclusive of site investigation, water use permit modification, facility planning, preliminary engineering in support of procuring design-build project delivery team.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The new membrane technology efficiently purifies the water beyond the capability of the existing technology and is expected to significantly reduced incidences of compliance actions. In addition, the significantly enhanced aesthetic characteristics of the water and improved compliance posture will improve consumer confidence and support economic development initiatives of the City. This could lead to fewer complaints by residents and business community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Nearly 42,000 customers served by RBUSD as well as thousands of visitors.



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e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project, once constructed will deliver significant benefits to the community including improved water quality, reliable service, climate resilient structures that meet modern codes, and enhanced economic vitality and community well being. This pre-construction phase for which funding is requested will support the pre-construction activities and procurement of a design-build team to deliver the project.

The measure of success may be determined by the City completing the contracting of a design-build project delivery team.
