e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

- Improve physical health: Reduces number of pedestrian and vehicular accidents caused by flooded roads. Improves water flow away from street. Methodology: Compare number of flooding complaints before and after the project. Compare level of flooding before and after the project using sensors.
- Enhance/preserve/improve environmental or fish and wildlife quality: Reduces oils, grease and trash pollutants from street runoff to waterways. Methodology: Compare the number of cleaning sweeps by stormwater operation crews, pre an post construction. Physically observe of water being retained in structures or swales for longer periods before running off into adjacent waterways.
- Improve wastewater management: Reduces oils, grease and trash pollutants from street runoff to waterways and reduces flood events. Methodology: Compare number of cleaning sweeps by stormwater operations crews on the improved stormwater control structures.
