12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal is to develop modern stormwater infrastructure while encouraging attainable housing and mixed-use commercial development in the Midtown area of Fort Myers. With increased density in the city infill area, the aim is to preserve water quality through low impact development practices and ground recharge. Project includes green infrastructure including but not limited to permeable soils or pavements, rain gardens, green roofs and storage of runoff for non-potable uses such as irrigation.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Along with preservation of open space that naturally filters runoff, the city funding will go towards design and construction of green infrastructure including but not limited to permeable soils or pavements, rain gardens, green roofs, storage of runoff for nonpotable uses such as irrigation, and enhancement of the water table though an exfiltration system.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Continued planning and design-build of stormwater systems benefiting City of Fort Myers citizens through this urban infill redevelopment project.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire City of Fort Myers is the target population, more than 100,000 individuals - residents and visitors - could be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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By implementing green initiatives, there will be a reduction in stormwater runoff into the Caloosahatchee. The decrease in untreated stormwater discharge to the Caloosahatchee can be measured by the amount of water collected, stored and reused through green infrastructure initiatives. Future Midtown residents are estimated to be at least 6,000 (from a current population of 650). There will be an increase in economic activity, resulting in tourism attraction extending visitor interest from adjacent historic downtown area that can be measured through business tax receipts and tax revenue generation.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

City would forfeit funds back to the state.
