- The property to be acquired will be converted into a park that will serve residents and visitors. The park location will offer new outdoor recreational opportunities in the form of multiuse trails, a fishing pier, a canoe/kayak launch, a picnic shelter, an observation platform, a nature center/museum = Park attendance for Pinellas County parks are tracked on an annual basis.

Florida Natural Areas Inventory. Acquiring the land and placing a conservation easement on a portion of the land will protective sensitive species present and improve habitat conditions for wildlife. = The property is comprised of 44.01 acres and it is anticipated that at least 25% of the land will be placed into a conservation easement.
 Acquisition of the Gladys Douglas property will increase tourism through the addition of a new park in Pinellas County with new opportunities for outdoor recreation such as fishing, kayaking, hiking, and wildlife viewing. = County parks are tracked on an annual basis.
