12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Construction of the infrastructure for a 75+/- acre business-industrial park which includes internal circulation roads, all onsite utilities, telecommunication/fiber, reconstruction of the main access road to the park, 3,350' of aircraft taxiway leading up to and in the park, and all required stormwater attenuation. The pad-ready building site(s) in the park will help attract between 350 and 500 new permanent jobs and capital investment in aviation and other business activity, thereby diversify the county's economy with growth in target industries and immediately stimulate the economy with the hiring of trade related workers during construction.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of the infrastructure for a 75+/- acre business park.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Construction jobs during the construction of the project and approximately 350 to 500 permanent jobs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents of the State of Florida as well as Citrus County will be served by this improvement and well over 800 persons will be impacted.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Construction of the infrastructure for a 75+/- acre business-industrial park which includes internal circulation roads, all onsite utilities, telecommunication/fiber, reconstruction of the main access road to the park, 3,350' of aircraft taxiway leading up to and in the park, and all associated stormwater treatment facilities. With infrastructure in place and pad ready sites to meet current new business facility demand, the park will support between 350 and 500 new jobs for the citizens of Citrus County, including accommodating aviation and other business related activities.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Standard contract penalties are sufficient.

The entire parcel was purchased and is controlled by the county and will be offered for private activity in pursuit of economic development purposes.
