12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

A new elevated storage tank is needed in order to have sufficient water available for all existing and future uses of the system. The West County public water supply wells, located in the Water Resource Caution Area, were taken out of service out of concern for the Floridan Aquifer cone of depression and long-term concerns of saltwater intrusion. The new elevated tank will enhance resiliency, prepare for future demand & is needed for additional storage, fire protection, and sustaining pressure.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This project will add system interconnections and water storage capacity. Further, it will increase fire protection capacity, sustain pressure during main breaks and fires (reducing the inconvenience of boil water notices), as well as enhance resiliency following tropical events with major power outages.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will improve drinking water quality by boosting efficiency of water resources. It will also reduce the reliance on the coastal portion of the Floridan Aquifer while adding system interconnections and water storage capacity.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents and visitors to Okaloosa County, which has a population over 200,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will improve drinking water quality by boosting efficiency of water resources.

The outcome will be measured by the following:

- Direct increase in water supply capacity;
- Sustainability of water pressure and flow into the West County Service area;
- Reduction of Water Boil Notices; and

• Positive changes in hydrologic data (rise in potentiometric surface of the local Floridan Aquifer, etc.)
