12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will improve the infrastructure in the Dorsey-Riverbend neighborhood in Fort Lauderdale, address water quality, and provide flood protection for the neighborhood, which will increase pedestrian and vehicle safety.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This project will line the existing 54-inch drainage pipe using concrete spin casting. This process will extend the life of pipe by an additional 50 years and preserve the stormwater integrity for the neighborhood. The project cost includes adding check valves, three (3) catch bins, and the roadway restoration and re-patching of depressed areas.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will receive improved stormwater infrastructure and resiliency.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Individuals that traverse NW 21st Avenue including the residents of the twenty homes along the roadway and those trying to reach the main thoroughfare and local businesses within this economically disadvantaged neighborhood.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will correct the extensive joint damage which is causing subsidence of the soils and the roadway on NW 21st Avenue. This project will also reduce flooding and extend the life of the existing pipe for an additional 50 years and preserve the stormwater and roadway integrity for the neighborhood.
