12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds would provide for an approximately 22, 579 square foot expansion of Central High School, which would allow for increased Career Certificate programs to be offered by the local school district.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

In addition to the current post-secondary offerings, Hernando County School District will look to create an increased menu of Career Certificate courses along with proper wraparound programs available to adults.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens of Hernando County will be able to enroll in up to 8 new Career Certificate courses at the new location. The Career Certificate courses would address the regional hiring needs, while maintaining the flexibility to adjust programs as the local needs change.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The expansion will serve new students to Sun Tech (the District's postsecondary provider), which is anyone who resides, or is willing to commute to, Hernando County. It will also allow for current high school students to take advantage of dual enrollment courses.

At capacity, this would open up 255 new seats, more than doubling what is currently available.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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The immediate benefit is to have the beginnings of a stand-alone facility that will house the expanded Career Certificate offerings in Hernando County, a community resource that is desperately needed. Accreditation will be sought by the Council of Occupational Education, which gives specific performance measures programs must adhere to in order to be eligible for federal funding.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

In the event that construction of the building does not move forward, all funds will be returned.
