The program will provide tutoring and homework help hours to "at-risk" Kindergarten through Grade 12 students and assist adult learners.

Improve quality of education:

The program will also administer the nationally normed pre-and post-assessments to document student academic progress in reading and writing. Student and teacher surveys.
