Funding was spent entirely for emergency assistance, mortgage assistance, business grants, COVID 19 sheltering, testing, and isolation and emergency personnel. Palm Beach will receive \$290,730,026 in American Rescue Plan funding which will be used on pandemic-related service and infrastructure projects.

Funds requested will provide for the improvement of water, wastewater and stormwater infrastructure in the Glades Region of Palm Beach County to improve water quality and supply as well as improve the resiliency of the infrastructure to reduce SSOs.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be utilized for construction of the needed infrastructure. The continued deterioration of the infrastructure has resulted in threats to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Glades Region. A more efficient, reliable and resilient sewer system with a reduction of infiltration can properly convey wastewater and reduces sanitary sewer overflows that release wastewater pollutants into the environment.

Direct and secondary improvements to water quality, supply and resilience.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this effort and associated projects includes the economically disadvantaged residents of the Glades Region of Palm Beach County.
