A Mobile Command Vehicle would provide a base of operations for the incident command structure utilized in the event of a disaster (natural or man-made), emergency, special event or to augment normal operations. Funding of this request would enable the purchase and deployment of a mobile command vehicle by the City of Plantation.

The City of Plantation Police Department will be better able to meet the public safety needs of the community in the event of a disaster, emergency or large scale special event.

The mobile command vehicle will provide for "portability" of public safety services in that it can be deployed in the area of need providing efficient and effective services to those in need.
