Goodwill South Florida offers vocational education & training programs where participants are taught job skills and gain work experience in positions within one of Goodwill's business divisions, in the areas of sewing, customer service/retail education and custodial services. Participants who successfully complete training are placed in paid positions with Goodwill and commercial / governmental organizations. The appropriation will provide a stipend to individuals enrolled in the sewing program. 80% of the population served are individuals with disabilities.
