Funding was spent entirely for emergency assistance, mortgage assistance, business grants, COVID-19 sheltering, testing, and isolation and emergency personnel. Palm Beach will receive \$290,730,026 in American Rescue Plan funding which will be used on pandemic-related service and infrastructure projects.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds secured through this project will mitigate stormwater runoff and pollutants loading into local water systems through the enhancement of existing roadway infrastructure within the central historic region of Palm Beach County.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

County departments will coordinate to engineer and construct enhanced roadways to modernize the historic region in tandem with revamping stormwater runoff systems.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improved roadways, runoff water quality, and infrastructure, much of which is more than fifty years old.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project targets the Central Palm Beach Historical Region comprised of 12 municipalities, though residents across the entire county will benefit from the project as they travel in the area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Palm Beach County Engineering and Public Works will monitor traffic and vehicle accident data following construction of infrastructure improvements. Palm Beach County's Environmental Resource Management Department will monitor both quantity of stormwater runoff and nutrient load as metrics to monitor success of improvements.
