4. Project/Program Description

To meet the future needs of the City of Oviedo, and to begin phase one of decommissioning the percolation ponds, we propose dismantling an existing 1.5-million-gallon reclaimed water storage tank at the Oviedo Water Reclamation Facility and constructing a new 2.0-Million-gallon tank in its place. The expanded storage will allow the City of Oviedo to effectively increase the public use of reclaimed water (Public Access effluent) for irrigation and to reduce the usage of potable water.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funding will allow the City of Oviedo to dismantle a rapid infiltration basin utilized for its wastewater system. The associated phase 1 improvements will also allow for increased diurnal storage for reclaimed water. The expanded storage will allow the City of Oviedo to effectively increase the public use of reclaimed water (Public Access effluent) for irrigation and to reduce the usage of potable water.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Dismantle an existing 1.5 MG tank, demolish the base slab, stabilize the soils beneath the old tank, construct a new base slab and construct a new taller tank with a 2.0 MG tank capacity.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Increased access to reclaimed water (Public Access effluent) for irrigation and to reduce the usage of potable water.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

City of Oviedo reclaimed water customers.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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The additional reclaimed water reduces the need to purchase supplemental reclaimed water from Seminole County. It also reduces the groundwater withdraw which benefits wetlands. Lastly the new tank will provide an additional available 500K gallons of reclaimed water to current users. Measuring the amount of reclaimed water homes/properties utilize and the reduction of potable water

Should the City fail to meet deliverables, it will return the state funding.
