4. Project/Program Description

A network of pedestrian sidewalks currently exist within the Boulevard Heights neighborhood; however, there are very few access ramps in place to allow pedestrians, especially those with disabilities, to safely cross the streets. The installation of additional sidewalks to fill in the gaps, and ADA compliant sidewalk ramps will improve connectivity, resulting in a comprehensive sidewalk network that will provide safe pedestrian accessibility to many local public facilities such as schools, neighborhood parks, and community centers. The additional sidewalk ramps will be designed to meet the most current ADA design guidelines to ensure pedestrian accessibility and ADA compliance.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The project funds will be used to achieve pedestrian sidewalk connectivity, safety, and accessibility for individuals with disabilities.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The primary service provided to citizens will be safe pedestrian access within the city owned right-of-way within the Boulevard Heights neighborhood.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Construction and installation of approximately 275 ADA compliant sidewalk ramps and associated sidewalk.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Boulevard Heights neighborhood, within the City of Hollywood. Based on the most recent Census data approximately 12.5 percent of residents in this area are living at or below the poverty level and 7.7 percent of individuals living in the area have a disability.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



The city anticipates that the installation of ADA accessible ramps and associate sidewalks in the neighborhood will reduce the number of ADA related right-of-way concerns from individuals with disabilities by 80 percent or more. The city tracks ADA concerns related to city facilities and services from citizens on an ongoing basis. The city will compare the number of ADA related right-of-way concerns for a period of 2 years before and after the project is completed.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Contracts will include enhanced liquidated damage provisions with amounts based on the most current FDOT standard specifications, payment and performance bonds, and retainage. Standard penalties for the contract with FDOT are sufficient.

The sidewalks will be constructed within city-owned right of ways.
