a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose we are requesting funding for is to build an Environmental Education Center. The center will be used to host all educational activities and educate 200,000+ public school children annually about the importance of wildlife and environmental conservation for many years to come.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Environmental Education Center will be the centerpiece of Busch Wildlife Sanctuary. Our goal in designing the facility is to highlight the ever-changing landscape of Florida, our impact on wildlife that we share our environment with, and how children and state residents can help preserve our precious natural resources

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

We offer a variety of everyday public programs with the goal of educating about Florida wildlife and the importance of environmental conservation. Open 6 days a week with free admission, the Sanctuary's permanent collection of approx. 200 animals are on display and provide hands-on learning opportunities & interactive displays to first hand about human impact on the environment & wildlife.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

More than 200,000 school children from across Florida. Additional visitors include FL residents and tourists.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

- 1) This unique facility offers a one-of-a-kind opportunity to learn about nature while providing a sanctuary for wildlife and people. We have something for everyone; young and old alike. From story time for parents with toddlers to family night-walks, education activities appeal to a broad range of people. This will be measured by the number of guests who visit.
  2) Children tend to perform better on standardized tests and have fewer attendance problems if they spend time outside. Measured by the number of students from across Florida who take field trips to Busch Wildlife Sanctuary to enhance their science curriculum and take part in our STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) related educational content.
- 3) Busch Wildlife Sanctuary serves Florida by helping sick, injured and orphaned wildlife. The public bring them to our hospital or a member of our trained, volunteer rescue team retrieve animals that are too dangerous for the public to intercept.
