This extension of the regional drinking water transmission will improve regional water system reliability, support growing water needs in northern Sarasota County, and set the stage for future installation of the final piece of regional pipeline connecting Manatee County to the Regional Water Supply System.

Design and construction of a regional drinking water transmission pipeline and associated pumping and storage facility.

Provides reliable and safe drinking water supply for public health, safety, and welfare of the residents and economic growth of the region consisting of Charlotte, DeSoto, Manatee, and Sarasota Counties.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The four-county region comprising the Authority's service area has a population of approximately 1,100,000 residents. The Authority's regional water supply system connects to utilities serving more than half of that population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Provides reliable water supply infrastructure to the region for economic development and public health and safety. The project enhances regional water supply resiliency to disasters such as drought, floods, hurricanes, and climate change. The outcome will be measured through improving water supply availability and maintaining the current high standards for drinking water quality under all foreseeable conditions.
