Students will learn concepts of navigation, physics, geography, geometry, and other techniques, and mathematical concepts to plot basic theoretical coordinates and more.

A thorough understanding of the available careers in the maritime industry, many related to STEM based occupations, such as marine engineers, captains, machinists, navigation, and electronic radar, also deck crew, culinary, housekeeping, and food services. Immediate job opportunities are available throughout the maritime industry. There is a serious shortage of workers. Jobs are now available and many are coupled with opportunities for advancing and obtaining certifications and rising in the ranks through career enhancement and training in various areas of the industry. Many maritime jobs pay above average wages. Most crews have quarters on the vessels, which helps them on their way to self-sufficiency. While they work they are able save to become self-sufficient and secure their own housing. If there is an available trained workforce to staff businesses, more vessels for transport, ferry, charter, dining, fishing, cruising, and other water craft activities, there will be options available to tourists and residents to enjoy our oceans, lakes, and rivers.
