12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of this project is to restore 22 acres of lost seagrass meadows into the Indian River Lagoon near Fort Pierce Inlet. The benefits of seagrass meadows include critically important functions for fisheries production, reducing harmful algae blooms, sediment stabilization, absorbing nutrients, and coastal resilience.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project funds will be used to permit and implement a seagrass restoration project. The benefits of the project will be communicates through public outreach campaigns. Seagrass for the project will be grown, planted, and protected in an area that has sufficient water quality for seagrass growth within the Indian River Lagoon.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Seagrass meadows are critical for good water quality, increase recreational opportunities, and reduce harmful algae blooms. Citizens will be directly benefited by the ecosystem services that seagrass provide.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will enhance the quality of the lagoon for all of its residents and the estimated 7.4 million tourists, that supply \$7.6 billion annually, who depend on a healthy lagoon.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of this project is to permanently restore seagrass meadows in the IRL utilizing scientifically validated techniques. Monthly maintenance and a three year monitoring program will take place to measure the success and outputs of this project.
