a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The technology will bridge the gap to provide real time critical intelligence in the field, which could lead to adverse risk to public safety personnel and the public. It will also enhance the comprehensive utilization of the RTCC's database and software to allow police, fire and city personnel to assist during critical incident situations, emergencies, and large-scale special events in the city. The Public Safety Mobile Command Center will also be utilized for community assistance operations to include the Homeless Outreach Program, Feeding South Florida Food Drives and COVID testing/vaccine site operations. The department will be able to assist smaller surrounding agencies that do not have the manpower or resources should such events take place in their jurisdiction.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Acquire a Public Safety Mobile Command Center and link the police department's Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) for live updates on investigations and emergency situations. Train all critical incident staff in the use of the public safety mobile command center.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Public Safety Mobile Command Center will greatly enhance the coordination and response to the citizens during a major incident or at an event.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The City of Boynton Beach alone has a population rate of over 76,000, this project will benefit the general population in our city and surrounding areas.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



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be measured?

Through enhanced technology reduce crime, respond more effectively to critical incidents and increase interoperability with other departments and jurisdictions. The effectiveness of the project will be measured by the number of deployments and successful operations.
