Muzology is seeking a \$960,000 appropriation request to do an extensive pilot program in Brevard, Collier, Duval, Escambia, Hernando, Hillsborough, Miami-Dade, Manatee, Pinellas, Polk and Pasco counties. Due to COVID, students across the state of Florida saw a 10 point drop in Math based competency. The pilot program would serve approximately 240,000 students in middle school in the identified counties for the 22-23 school year. The pilot would be used to map and mitigate learning loss in algebra readiness due to COVID-19.

#### 12. Program Performance

#### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Goal: Improve math learning, engagement, and achievement among middle school students and rapidly fill in learning gaps due to the pandemic. Muzology is a nationally-recognized learning platform that teaches math through the power of music. Muzology uses instructional math music videos (mapped to FL standards) to make learning math fun, engaging and effective for students of ALL levels of proficiency. Muzology is SEL-aligned and a proven evidence-based solution for math learning and recovery.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

FULL access to Muzology's award-winning, digital math platform. Access is 24-7 on any internet connected device. Muzology uses instructional math music videos and associated formative assessments to make math relevant and engaging for ALL students. Muzology is a supplemental learning tool that is mapped to FL standards and evidence-based, SEL-aligned and ESSER-aligned.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Muzology's learning platform (containing instructional math music videos and formative assessments, plus assignment features and student/teacher analytics) will be provided to approximately 240,000 Florida middle school students across 11 counties. Includes ongoing professional development, training, and support to ensure seamless and effective implementation plus technical support.

240,000 middle school students in Brevard, Collier, Duval, Escambia, Hernando, Hillsborough, Miami-Dade, Manatee, Pinellas, Polk and Pasco counties.

To close the achievement gap for middle school students for pre-algebra and algebra readiness. Be measured through in-platform formative math assessments, in-platform engagement metrics, class math grades, class attendance, measures of class behavior issues, state testing scores, teacher reports, student self-reports, and qualitative assessments of math enjoyment, confidence, and self-efficacy.
