Protect the general public from harm (environmental, criminal, etc.): Same as #2.

4.Improve stormwater management: same as #2.

5. Improve transportation conditions: Comparing number of traffic accidents of affected roadways and from observation of better traffic flows due to reduced flooding in travel ways.
