The Lake Conine Recreation Elements Project is located on the southeast shore of Lake Conine in the under-served northeast area of Winter Haven. The original 1850 plat depicts the lake and historic wetlands. The city acquired this property to re-establish an effective wetland/stormwater park. The 32 acre project will complement the natural environment with three trails, fishing pier, kayak launch, picnic facilities, and educational elements.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The development of the park elements of the trail system, picnic areas, boardwalks, fishing pier, playground, parking area, kayak launch, and other amenities will allow residents to access and enjoy this new 32 acre park.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Residents will be able to live active lifestyles through walking and biking in the park. The additional amenities within this peaceful lake-shore park will provide needed respite and recreation to the underserved adjacent neighborhoods.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The construction of the recreation elements within the Lake Conine Wetland Park.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This public park will serve all citizens, specifically the adjacent Boggy Bottom Neighborhood and the residents of northeast Winter Haven. There is a mix of single family and multi-family housing within walking distance of the site and the park will provide direct pedestrian access to several hundred residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

The benefit and outcome of the project is to provide residents and the adjacent neighborhoods direct and additional access to recreational opportunities. Currently the city does not have a park directly serving this neighborhood. Providing access to the 32 acre parkland will be the measurement to achieve this outcome.
