a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal is to create a construction academy to be located at Interlachen Jr. Sr. High School with clear alignment from K-12 to the workforce in order to meet the demands of service areas that are plagued by unfilled professional positions.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A construction academy will be located at Interlachen High School and will include construction courses in general construction to entail masonry, electrical, framing, roofing, HVAC, and plumbing. Equipment and supplies will be purchased to start the construction academy.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Students will be trained in the high-demand construction field so that students are prepared to enter post-secondary programs and the workforce, meeting the professional needs of Putnam County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Approximately 75 students will be highly trained each year to fill the construction needs.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome is that students will attain industry certification in high-demand service areas aligned to State of Florida career and technical pathways.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The contracting agency may consider asking for financial reimbursement if students are not enrolled in the construction academy during a three year period.
