### 12. Program Performance

### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this appropriation is to control existing mosquito infestations in the Town and to reduce and prevent future infestations. This request will fund additional spraying in the city for immediate reductions, and also to establish and implement a program of mosquito control and spraying at each of the Town's multiple water bodies. The requested funds will be used to support additional equipment, supplies, personnel, and subcontractor assistance in the Town's mosquito control efforts.

### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities that will be provided to meet the purpose of reducing disease-carrying and pest species of mosquitoes in chronic problem areas of Dundee comprise a two-fold strategy of 1) targeted ground spraying and aerial treatments in immediate problem areas, and 2) establishing a long-term preventive program of regular and intensified spraying of existing and potential mosquito habitat areas.

### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

It is anticipated that this work will result in a significant drop in mosquito populations throughout the Town. This reduction of mosquito populations and breeding areas will result in the effective reduction of the threat of mosquito-borne diseases such as West Nile Virus, Eastern Equine Encephalitis, St. Louis Encephalitis, and Zika Virus.

### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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Elderly persons, persons with poor physical health, homeless persons, and the general resident population. The project will also serve visitors to Dundee seeking to use outdoor facilities, parks, trails, etc., within the Town.

Number of individuals expected to be served is 7,000: 5,000 town residents and 2,000 annual visitors (estimated).

### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

It is anticipated that this work will result in a significant drop in mosquito populations throughout the Town. This reduction of mosquito populations and breeding areas will result in the effective reduction of the threat of mosquito-borne diseases such as West Nile Virus, Eastern Equine Encephalitis, St. Louis Encephalitis, and Zika Virus. Direct and specific measurement of this benefit is difficult if not impossible. Mosquitoes and the diseases they carry are diffuse threats to public health and safety, and as such defy direct measurement. Reduction in the number of mosquitoes caught in infestation-assessment traps can serve as a reasonable surrogate measurement of population reduction and threat reduction.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalties are not appropriate as this appropriations local funding initiative request is for funding to support mosquito control activities in Dundee. Best efforts and best practices will be followed in order to attain adequate mosquito control, but end results are dependent on natural processes and as such are not subject to penalties.

The Town of Dundee will receive the fixed capital outlay funding for purchase of equipment needed to carry out the purpose and activities of this local funding initiative. Project mosquito-control treatment activities will be carried out within the municipality limits of the Town of Dundee.
