12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Conduct a rigorous high school academic competition to stretch our most accomplished students, defray costs for participating teams, sharpen skills for teachers of high performing students, and provide high achieving students the appropriate recognition they deserve.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

- 1. Training and materials to educators that enable them to work with students on rigorous, academically-focused extracurricular activities
- 2. Training to teachers with subject-area expertise to write and review questions related to state curricular benchmarks 3. Production of electronic displays, graphic displays, and audio components to aid in the presentation of questions
- during the competition

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Grants provided to assist with the cost of student accommodations and registration

Local – İndividual district academic teams use materials developed by the Ăcademic Tourney to prepare teams for local competition.

Regional – district academic teams come together for pre-tournament scrimmages using materials developed by the Academic Tourney to prepare for state-level competition

Statewide – all school districts are invited by The Commissioner to send a six member team to participate in the state competition in April to compete for the title of State Champion

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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High-achieving students in grades 9 to 12 from across Florida. The project is expected to directly serve 350-375 students at the state tournament and indirectly serve an indeterminate number of students who participate in individual school, district and regional academic competitions throughout the year by providing participating school districts with materials and support for local competitions.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Florida's high performing high school students benefit by exposure to rigorous and academically challenging curricular content aligned to our state standards and the award of academic scholarships.

FDOE grant evaluation and participant surveys

- 1. The tournament will recruit 35% of Florida's school districts to participate.
- 2. The tournament will increase the number of followers of its Facebook page by 500 by the conclusion of the event
- 3. The tournament will determine what aspects of arrangements, communications, and actual events should be continued and/or expanded.
