Provide a youth intervention program that meets the targeted needs of Clay County youth by providing effective diversion and intervention programs which includes redirection of youth through community service, mentoring and academic assistance to prevent juvenile delinquency. Program services will be provided to youth who are identified as at-risk of becoming involved in the juvenile system who are ages 6 to 18 years old.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Effective diversion and intervention programs which include redirection of youth through community service, mentoring, and academic assistance.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Mentoring, tutoring, and intervention.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Persons with poor mental health, at-risk youth, grade school students, and high school students. Over 800 individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefits include improved mental health, improved quality of education, and protect the general public from harm. Crime rates, youth organization surveys, and comparison studies in local schools can be used to measure the program's success.
