4. Project/Program Description

Dixie County intends to construct a new +/- 11,000 SF fire station including engine bays, bunk rooms, common areas, parking area, and storm water retention area will protect approximately 17,000 residents and countless tourists who come to enjoy natural North Florida. Dixie County does not have a 24-hour hospital for emergency care. Citizens rely heavily on trained emergency response for stabilization and most tourists aren't aware there is no hospital when they come to camp in this area. Many of our citizens live over 90 minutes from a 24-hour hospital with an emergency center. This project will allow for manned stations where there are currently none. A fire and EMS assessment was completed to determine the appropriate charges needed to fund the County's fire/rescue stations now and in the future. Over 50 citizens attended the August 5, 2021, BOCC meeting and overwhelmingly supported the increased assessment from \$40 to \$125 annually allowing the County to afford manned stations.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

These funds will be used for the construction of a new +/- 11,000 SF fire station including engine bays, bunk rooms, common areas, parking area, and stormwater retention area will protect approximately 17,000 residents and countless tourists who come to enjoy natural North Florida. To seek architectural/engineering design, permitting, bidding, construction project management and construction services to design and construct a permanent fire station to serve and protect all stakeholders including citizens, visitors, and the business community of Dixie County.

This permanent station will help to protect the lives, welfare, and property of all stakeholders within Dixie County and surrounding areas by providing excellent service in the event of natural or other disasters through the effective use of current techniques in fire suppression, fire prevention, vehicle extrication, hazardous materials mitigation, emergency medical services, and public education.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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All stakeholders including citizenry, visitors, residents, businesses and surrounding areas. United States Census Bureau population estimate for Dixie County is 16,589.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Response times will be significantly reduced to stakeholders in Dixie County, thereby increasing survivability, and better overall outcomes for aforementioned stakeholders involved in emergent events. These outcomes will be measured by current Insurance Service Office and National Fire Protection Association 1710 recommendations for response times and manpower. Also the building of a permanent fire station will encourage economical development of this region and provide a sense of security in the business community.
