a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To establish the infrastructure and platform from which proprietary information regarding marine and oceanographic-related research may be shared between FIU, FAU, Nova Southeastern University, and the University of Miami to allow the universities to share and build off of each other's research, collect industry-related data, determine economic impact of research and commercialization efforts to broaden MRH's global impact.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Marine-related research contributes to innovations in sectors like biomedicine and biotechnology and impacts aquaculture, fisheries, pharmaceuticals, tourism, and recreation.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Increased economic activity and diversity, increased tourism and recreation, increased jobs, and job creation.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Floridians and the general population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increased innovations and discoveries from marine-related research in the biotechnology and biomedical industries; increased solutions for the preservation and protection of Florida's ecosystems and environment; and increased job opportunities in sectors like shipbuilding, biomedicine, biotechnology, fisheries, aquaculture, and pharmaceuticals.
