The main purpose of this project is to upgrade an undersized and aged 6" water main to the minimum required size of 12" to provide the necessary water pressures and quantity for fire protection as well as to meet current water demands. This project will reduce any economic losses due to undersized water main potable water to local residents and businesses.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Contracted activity and services under this funding include surveying, demolition, clearing, geotechnical services, design, permitting, cost estimating and construction of water line improvements.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This is a much-needed public and safety project as documented in several local meetings with support by residents and elected officials. The main services of this project include protecting the safety of public by providing the required pressure and water demand for fire protection as well as potable use.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population of this projects are local residents, as well as business and users of potable/drinking water in the area that will benefit with the safety provisions of the project by providing fire protection and water demand.
