4. Project/Program Description

This project will mitigate gun violence by providing Officers real-time gunfire intelligence data. The goals are to dispatch police to precise gunfire locations 90% of the time, increase police response time by 80%, increase officer safety by 60%, increase retrieval of key forensic evidence by 60% and increase the ability to render life-saving aid to victims by 60%.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal is to mitigate gun violence in the South side of the City that received a total of 480 calls for gun shots fired for the 2020 year, which is a 70% increase from 2019.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Shotspotter is subscription services that uses strategically placed sensors within a 4 mile radius of the City's targeted area uses software to detect and locate gunfire with an increased Officer response time by 90%. Shotspotter will provide comprehensive data to protect officers by providing critical situational awareness and increased life-saving aid to victims.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Shotspotter provides critical information in real-time allowing Officers to respond and render life-saving aid to victims as well as increased safety measures.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population is the South side of the City comprised of approximately 30,000 residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

The outcome will be reduced gun violence by 60% and measurable through data supporting detailed forensic analysis of gunfire incidents as reported through Detailed Forensic Report (DFR) documentation that is court-admissible to verify timing, sequence and location of each shot fired as well as to obtain search warrants or to investigate Officer involved shootings.



f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalties include written notification to correct within 30 days, if still not corrected the agency shall submit termination of agreement in writing to include effective date and if terminated prior to project completion the Agency shall only pay for the percentage of the project satisfactorily performed for which cost can be substantiated.
