4. Project/Program Description

This project will renovate and enhance three parks (Central Ridge Community Park, Beverly Hills Community Park, Central Ridge District Park) located in Beverly Hills, FL, in Citrus County. The improvement of the Beverly Hills Community Park, Central Ridge Community Park, and Central Ridge District Park will provide the community with a safe, interactive, and attractive green space where residents and kids can come together to promote community wellness and engagement. Beverly Hills, Florida, is the most densely populated area in Citrus County. It is also one of the most economically vulnerable areas in Citrus County. There is a lack of economic opportunities and high crime. The potential of sports development for travel sports, safe planned green spaces with future nature tourism, and economic development opportunities are sorely needed. This local funding request will be a powerful tool to address the numerous challenges that District 3 is facing today.

Cty rcvd. two fed. assistance grants: CARES & ARPA. Total CARES was \$26,113,992. Funds were used for: Small Bus Prgm, Food Prgms, Public Safety payroll and Public Health Expenses. The Cty will receive \$29,069,118 in ARPA funds. To date we have received 50% (\$14,534,559) and the remaining 50% will be paid next year. Funds will be committed to Water/Wastewater projs (\$20 mil), with remaining funds to capital investments in public facilities & health expenses.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Parks, Green Spaces and Community Common Areas, play a vital role in economic, social, mental and physical wellbeing of America's Counties and their residents. The remodeling, expansion, and development of existing and new recreational areas and facilities will take place. The restrooms, concession stands, and skate park will be remodeled. We will add a multi-purpose pavilion, pickleball courts, nature trail connector, graffiti wall, beach volleyball courts, youth football facility, dog park, game top picnic tables, splash pad, and security cameras. The revitalization of these parks will encouraged physical activity, mental well being, arts, culture and enhance property values.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

While this project may initially attract the local community of 9,360 citizens, the intent is to serve the entire county of approximately 150,000 residents of Citrus County and our visitors and tourists.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Construction of the project will include the remodeling, expansion, and development of existing and new recreational areas and facilities. The restrooms, concession stands, and skatepark will be remodeled. We will add a multi-purpose pavilion, pickleball courts, nature trail connector, graffiti wall, beach volleyball courts, youth football facility, dog park, game top picnic tables, splash pad, and security cameras. We expect a spur in economic growth, an increase in property values and visitors, and a significant decrease or elimination of crime. The outcome will be measured by monitoring the growth and development in District 3, the number of visitors, and the reduction of crime.

The significant remodeling, expansion, and development of existing and new recreational areas and facilities of these three Community Parks will not occur.
